



According to the NEA (National Education Association) only about 68 percent of all students nationally who enter 9th grade will graduate "on time" with regular diplomas in 12th grade. While the graduation rate for White students is 75 percent, only approximately half of Black, Latino, and Native American students earn regular diplomas alongside their classmates. Graduation rates are even lower for minority males.

Literacy and lack of second chances affect our entire country through increased crime rates, unemployment rates, decreased self-esteem, pride in life, and value on life.
